

New look to £400m scheme

A MODIFIED £400million regeneration scheme could create up to 6,000 jobs.

The development proposal for the area, north-east of Belfast city centre, has been revised following feedback from the public.

A spokesman for developer Castlebrooke Investment said: "We listened carefully during the public consultation to people passionate about the city and have modified our plans."

The project will include a new connection between North Street and Donegal Street, as well as routes from Royal Avenue and Rosemary Street.

All seven of the listed buildings in the area are being restored and put back into use which includes the provision of cultural space.
